We are writing to express our thanks for your comments regarding Treasury's obligation pursuant to the recent change to the IRC §911 housing cost limitation to take geographic differences into consideration. Consistent with the success that you have achieved regarding your mandate to provide taxpayers with regulatory guidance promptly, we support your efforts to do so in this area. As you know, this change is significant due to its retroactivity, and our members are very anxious to utilize regulatory guidance that will provide a meaningful and realistic adjustment to the housing cost limitation for those employees working in high-cost jurisdictions.

The NFTC has served as the head of the §911 Ad Hoc Working Group for the last several years, coalescing with various associations and organizations to increase awareness of the importance of U.S. workers in foreign assignments.
