Dear Minister Tanigaki:

We are writing to express our support for the recently renegotiated tax treaty between Japan and the United States and to urge its prompt ratification. Both Japanese and American companies stand to gain a great deal upon the completion of this monumental treaty, and early ratification will further facilitate commerce between our countries. The treaty provides for early implementation of the provisions that eliminate certain withholding taxes if the ratification process is completed by the end of March.

The National Foreign Trade Council (NFTC), organized in 1914, is an association of over 300 U.S. business enterprises. Our members, many of which are significant investors in Japan, covers a full spectrum of industrial, commercial, financial, and service activities. The NFTC leads the U.S. business community in matters of tax treaty negotiation and ratification as part of its advocacy of an open world trading system.

Members of the NFTC would very much appreciate completion of the ratification process by both countries by the end of March. It is our understanding that the U.S. is on schedule in that regard. The Senate Foreign Relations Committee will hold a ratification hearing on February 25th in order to allow sufficient time for completion of all of the ratification procedures by the end of March.
