Request for Comments Concerning Proposed Action in Section 301 Investigations of Various Economies Related to the Failure to Impose and Effectively Enforce a Prohibition on the Importation of Goods Produced with Forced Labor Rights

The National Foreign Trade Council (NFTC) appreciates the opportunity to provide input for the Office of the U.S. Trade Representative's (USTR) Federal Register notice, *USTR Notice of Determinations and Request for Comments Concerning Actions in Section 301 Investigations of Acts, Policies, and Practices of Various Economies Related to the Failure To Impose and Effectively Enforce a Prohibition on the Importation of Goods Produced With Forced Labor* ("the FR notice") (Vol. 91 No. 108 FR 34272, June 5, 2026). The comments in this submission apply to all countries that are the subject of investigations listed in the FR notice.

About NFTC

I. Introduction

NFTC and our member companies share the unequivocal view that forced labor practices are abhorrent and have no place in a modern, ethical global economy. Recognizing the gravity of this issue, responsible companies have invested heavily in, and worked diligently to deploy, sophisticated supply chain tracing technologies, third-party auditing mechanisms, and robust supplier codes of conduct to ensure that goods in their supply chains are not produced using forced labor. Industry is fully aligned with the goal of eradicating forced labor and continues to dedicate significant capital and operational resources to identifying and mitigating these practices wherever they may occur.

For this reason, NFTC made the case in our [submission for the original 301 investigation](#) that broad-based tariffs are a blunt, punitive measure that is unlikely to be an effective tool for eliminating forced labor. Moreover, a comprehensive tariff penalizes all goods from a country – including those from companies that have invested heavily to eliminate forced labor from their supply chains. For example, companies that are certified with Customs and Border Protection's (CBP) Customs Trade Partnership

Against Terrorism (CTPAP) program meet stringent government-established forced labor requirements.

The goal of this investigation and any remedy should be to encourage countries to adopt policies that prevent the use of forced labor practices and trade in goods produced with forced labor.

However, should USTR ultimately proceed with the proposed tariffs of 10 or 12.5 percent on goods from all 60 countries covered by this investigation, tariffs should be used to incentivize improved forced labor policies and enforcement. USTR should provide clear objectives and benchmarks that must be met, and once countries have corrected problems, the additional duty should be eliminated.

Notwithstanding NFTC's perspective on the approach of utilizing broad-based tariffs, we appreciate USTR's consideration of the following views on how the proposed tariffs in this investigation should be implemented. This includes comments on the proposed scope, exclusions, and additional elements for consideration.

II. NFTC Comments on the Proposed Tariff Remedy

The NFTC welcomed recent statements from Ambassador Greer that the United States would comply with tariff commitments it had made in agreements on reciprocal trade and other bilateral trade deals. The United States should follow through on its commitments and implement any Section 301 tariffs in a manner that conforms with bilateral tariff provisions of these agreements; otherwise, there is a risk that our trade partners will not deliver on their side of the agreement and important outcomes of ARTs could be lost.

NFTC supports and wants to emphasize the importance of USTR's recommendations to exclude several important categories of goods from the proposed duties. It is critical that the following exclusions are maintained:

- products subject to 232 duties;
- qualifying goods under the US-Mexico-Canada Agreement;
- Strategic products and products that are otherwise not available in the United States, including critical inputs and natural resources as listed in Annex A of the Federal Register notice. Annex A appears to reflect the treatment of products in Annexes II and III of the July 31 Executive Order *Further Modifying Reciprocal Tariff Rates under IEEPA* and Annexes I and II of the February 20 Section 122 Proclamation *Imposing a Temporary Import Surcharge to Address Fundamental International Payments Problems*.

In addition, NFTC urges USTR to incorporate several additional provisions discussed below in the final remedy to provide continuity with the previous IEEPA and Section 122 tariff regimes and minimize disruptions as new Section 301 tariffs are adopted.

- **Transition Periods:** When USTR publishes the final remedy, a commercially meaningful transition period will be critical so that companies have time to modify their compliance systems and adjust sales contract terms. The transition period should also include an exclusion from the new duties for goods that are on the water in transit to the United States by a certain deadline.

- **Duty Drawback:** Access to duty drawback for Section 301 tariffs is an important tool for U.S. producers who import components and raw materials to manufacture goods in the U.S. for export. Duty drawback was available for both the IEEPA and Section 122 tariffs and should be allowed for any Section 301 tariffs imposed in this investigation.
- **Section 232 Scope Changes:** The proposed exclusion for products that are subject to Section 232 duties is a welcome proposal. However, the scope of products subject to Section 232 duties (particularly for steel and aluminum derivative products) has been in flux. While dropping strategic products from the steel and aluminum 232 duties was also a welcome move, further changes to products covered by Section 232 duties could result in the application of Section 301 duties when products are no longer paying Section 232 tariffs. USTR should review any products that are removed from Section 232 duties and consider whether to maintain a Section 301 exclusion by adding the products to Annex A based on a determination that the additional duty is not in the strategic interests of the US.
- **Exclusion of Used Goods:** USTR should distinguish low-risk used goods from newly manufactured imports and exclude qualifying used goods from any Section 301 tariff remedy through the creation of a specific Chapter 99 HTS number for imports of used goods. Unlike newly manufactured products, used (or second-hand) goods are not the primary driver of the trade practices or supply chain concerns that are the subject of these investigations. Used goods do not present the same risk profile as newly produced merchandise and are not materially connected to the acts, policies, and practices under review. Imposing additional duties on these products would do little to advance the underlying policy objectives of these investigations. In most cases, these items were manufactured years earlier and are being resold through secondary markets by individuals and small businesses. As a result, tariffs on used goods would create disproportionate costs for consumers and small businesses while generating little leverage against the foreign trade practices under investigation. This approach would create a clear distinction for low-risk products. Such a framework could include a tailored definition of used goods and continued CBP enforcement authority to address fraud, evasion, or misclassification.
- **Additional Product Exclusions:** While NFTC welcomes the incorporation of Annex A to maintain the product exclusions that were previously provided for IEEPA and Section 122 tariffs, we request that USTR add critical products to the annex. NFTC's list of these proposed HTS numbers is attached to this submission as Annex I and reflects important goods that are strategic to U.S. interests or are not available in the United States. Further to our requested modification to Annex A, NFTC recommends that USTR provide a periodic public consultation to consider additional goods for inclusion in Annex A to ensure goods facing critical shortages or supply chain shocks in the future can be excluded from Section 301 duties.
- **Company / Importer Certification:** Companies have taken significant measures to comply and exceed U.S. forced labor requirements. USTR should consider options that recognize and reward compliance efforts. Importers that comply with CBP's CTPAT Tier 3 and Trade Compliance programs are required to maintain rigorous, CBP-validated systems to eliminate forced labor from their supply chains, directly advancing the goals of the proposed Section 301 action. Subjecting these verified trusted traders to additional tariffs penalizes companies

that have already made substantial investments in proven compliance and risk management. By utilizing an existing CBP-established program in order to grant participants an exemption or reduced tariff rate appropriately rewards these investments, incentivizes broader industry compliance, helps companies meet the administration's objectives, and allows agencies to focus enforcement resources on higher-risk imports.

III. NFTC Comments for Specific Consultation Prompts:

- The specific products to be subject to increased duties, including whether products should be retained or removed from the scope of the action, or whether products currently listed in Annex A should be added to the scope of the action*

The exclusions captured by Annex A are critical to NFTC members and we support excluding all products currently listed. NFTC requests that the additional 8-digit HTS numbers for strategic and unavailable products listed in Annex I to this submission be added to Annex A for exemption from the Section 301 duties.

- Whether products listed in Annex A are appropriately excluded*

As highlighted above, NFTC agrees with the exclusion of all products listed on Annex A. NFTC requests additional exclusions to minimize economic disruption, administrative complexity, and inflationary impacts on U.S. consumers and, furthermore, should there be any future tariff actions, it is necessary to mirror the current approach and to avoid stacking:

1. **Section 232 Products Remain Excluded:** NFTC strongly supports USTR's proposed exemption for goods already subject to Section 232 tariffs. Similarly, should there be future 232 actions, it is equally critical that these sectors be exempt from section 301 tariffs.
2. **Limit the Stacking of Tariffs:** The Administration has several other investigations underway, including its overcapacity 301 and country-specific 301s. The administration must be intentional to avoid or limit the stacking of tariffs across trade actions. Stacking multiple tariffs onto individual imports from different countries or industries creates an overwhelmingly complex and burdensome compliance environment. U.S. companies are currently dedicating immense capital to deploy advanced traceability technologies and third-party auditing to comply with the Uyghur Forced Labor Prevention Act (UFLPA) and other global due diligence mandates. Layering additional tariffs drains resources that would otherwise be spent advancing these critical supply chain transparency efforts. A formal, transparent "de-stacking" provision must be integrated into any final action.

- The level of the increase, if any, in the rate of duty*

NFTC does not believe that either the proposed 10 percent or 12.5 percent tariff rates need to be higher. Rather, as discussed in the next question, NFTC would like to see countries that strengthen their enforcement of forced labor regimes rewarded with rates below 10 percent. It is further necessary to ensure the increases do not exceed rates agreed to in the administration's bilateral negotiations.

- *Whether different tariff rates should be applied to an economy where the economy has made a commitment to the United States to impose and enforce a forced labor import prohibition; has imposed a forced labor import prohibition; or has imposed a partial regime with the effect of preventing the importation of certain forced labor goods.*

NFTC supports USTR's proposal to apply a lower tariff rate to countries described above. Ultimately, we would like to see countries that make progress rewarded for their efforts with rates lower than 10 percent. USTR should define a transparent process, with appropriate benchmarks, which if met would result in the removal or lowering of tariffs.

V. Conclusion

NFTC supports U.S. efforts to reduce and disincentivize forced labor throughout global supply chains with other countries abiding by laws and trade requirements commensurate with the United States. In doing so, it must not come at the cost of U.S. manufacturing and trade competitiveness or at the expense of the American consumer.
